		Check and fill pump oil reservoir	
		Check and clean pump air filter basket	
		Drain oil catch muffler	
		Check all fittings on pump for wear	
		Check driveline and moving parts	
		Inspect mount system for loose or cracked parts	
		Check condition of pump/trailer hot hose	

Trailer System

OK	Needs Attention	Procedure	Repairs Made
		Drain secondary moisture trap	
		Check vacuum/pressure gauges - replace if needed	
		Check pressure/vacuum relief valves are free of debris	
		Check manway seals and bolts/nuts	
		Check valves, fittings and hoses for wear and chafing	
		Check sight tubes for leaks or blockage	
		Check scrubber system hoses and lids	
		Check all Danger/Warning labels are in place and visible	
		Verify all attachments and hoses are stored properly for transit	
		Complete tractor/trailer pre/post inspection forms
